



Late Round NFL Starter on the Verge of Free Agency Becomes Disabled

A former seventh-round NFL draft choice was scheduled to be an unrestricted free agent next season. Being a multi-year starter in the NFL, he was in the position to command a new contract with a significant signing bonus in free agency.
